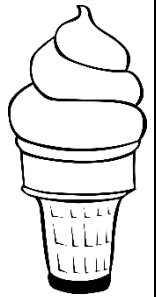

Simple Cinquains

A **cinquain** (pronounced “sin-kane”) is a five-line poem that describes something. It has rules for the number of syllables on each line.

Cinquain Rules	Example
Line 1: Two syllables – Title Line 2: Four syllables – Description Line 3: Six syllables – Action Line 4: Eight syllables – Feeling Line 5: Two syllables – Conclusion	Ice cream. Cold and tasty. Melting, dripping, pleasing. It feels so good in my tummy. Yummy.
