

Fun with Haiku

A **haiku** (pronounced “hi-koo”) is a three-line poem, often about a season or nature. It has rules for the number of syllables on each line. Usually, the last line makes an observation.

Haiku Rules	Example
Line 1: Five syllables Line 2: Seven syllables Line 3: Five syllables	Winter is coming. Snow will be arriving soon. We should rake the leaves.
