Lively Limericks

A **limerick** is a funny, five-line poem that tells a story, often about a person. It has an AABBA rhyme scheme, and a rhythmical pattern.

Limerick Rules	Example
Limericks are five lines long	There was a young fellow named Hall
Rhymes on lines 1, 2, and 5	Who fell in the spring in the fall.
Another rhyme on lines 3 and 4	'Twould have been a sad thing
Rhythm is "da DUM da"	Had he died in the spring,
Lines 3 and 4 are shorter	But he didn't—he died in the fall.
